



## **Directions to Dumfries and Galloway Royal Infirmary:**

### **DGRI from the South**

From the M6/A74(M) Northbound, at junction 22, exit toward Dumfries / Stranraer.

Merge onto the A75, and continue for approximately 21 miles.

You will come to a roundabout (immediately after passing a Little Chef and a Shell garage). Take the 1st exit onto the A780 - Annan Road.

Continue through two roundabouts over the next 1.5 miles.

At the next roundabout, take the 1st exit onto the A756 – Brooms Road.

Continue through one roundabout over the next  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile.

Carry on to next set of lights keeping in the left hand lane - the next set of lights will take you left onto the Whitesands. Keep left here but take the right hand lane turning left.

This will take you up to another set of lights, take the right hand lane turning right onto B725 – St. Michael Street. Continue for the next  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile through one roundabout (3rd exit).

At the next set of traffic lights, bear left onto Bankend road, the visitors entrance to the hospital is the 2nd on the right. For A&E and the Dental Centre, take the next right.

## **DGRI from the North**

From the A74(M) Southbound, at junction 15, take the A701 exit to Dumfries / Beattock.

At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto the A701 heading to Glasgow / A74(M) / Edinburgh / Dumfries / Beattock.

Proceed under the A74(M), and at the next roundabout take the 1st exit and stay on the A701 heading to Dumfries for the next 18.5 miles. Continue through two roundabouts (2nd exit for both), the 2nd of which crosses the A75.

After ¼ a mile, the road forks in two. Bear left onto Moffat Road. Continue for ½ a mile. The Hospital A&E is signposted from here.

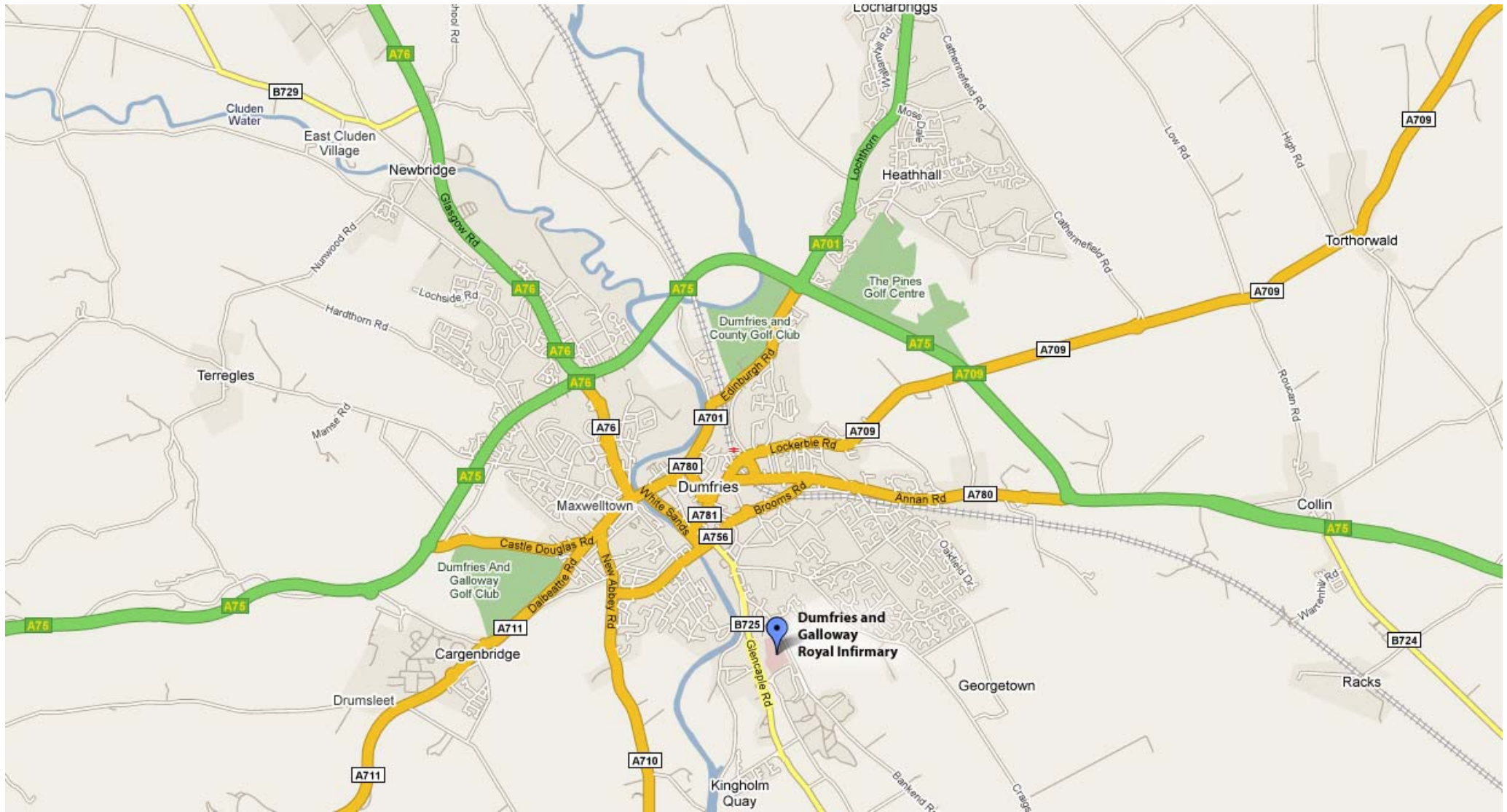
At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto the A709 – St. Mary's Street. Continue through one roundabout.

Make a slight right where St. Mary's Street turns into the A780 - English Street.

After less than 200 yards, the A780 – English Street turns slightly left and becomes A781 – Shakespeare Street. Continue to follow the road in the left hand lane.

Take a slight left onto B725 – St. Michael Street and continue straight through the traffic lights, and the next roundabout (3rd exit).

At the next set of traffic lights, bear left onto Bankend road, the visitors entrance to the hospital is the 2nd on the right. For A&E and the Dental Centre, take the next right.
