

SURVEY MONKEY COMPETITION

The multi agency survey has been developed in a partnership as part of an approach to deliver appropriate and worthwhile information to those who may need it. It is hoped that by collecting responses from a range of people, future campaigns & information can be improved and will go some way to helping people make better choices about their health & well being.

As part of this campaign, condom wallets have been designed and created with the involvement of all three agencies and young people. These will be distributed throughout Dumfries & Galloway as part of a year long campaign focusing on the following three main areas;

1. Alcohol Awareness campaign. Culminates for Alcohol Awareness Week 4th October
2. Sexual health, condoms & relationships. Culminates for Sexual Health week 25th January 2010
3. Domestic Abuse and Violence Against Women to include 16 Days of Activism Against Gender Violence. Culminates 10 December

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Entrants must be over the age of 13 to take part
2. To be eligible for an IPOD all sections of the questionnaire must be completed
3. All entries will remain confidential & anonymised.
4. Identifying details will be allocated a number which will replace those details on the responses prepared for feedback.
5. The number and linked personal identifying information will be kept on an NHS secure server, where it can only be accessed by one administrator.
6. Entry is not dependent on the type of responses
7. Draws will take place on the 10th October, 20th December 2009 & 31st January 2010.
8. Winners will be notified by telephone.
9. Responses will be collated into groups and fed back during promotional activities on local radio, newspapers and through all the key agencies involved.
10. All analysis will also be anonymous.
11. Winners may opt in to take part in promotional coverage if they chose.
