

THE HERBERT PROTOCOL

The “Herbert Protocol” Missing Vulnerable Person Incident Form is designed to make sure if someone goes missing, the police can get access to important information about that person as soon as possible.



When should I complete this?

The form should be completed by the individual(s) who are most familiar with the person named in this document. It should be updated as necessary on a regular basis

What will happen to this information when I have completed the form?

Only hand over the protocol to the police if the person goes missing. It will be used to help them find your loved one as soon as possible.

We will never share your information with anyone else, unless as a part of a live investigation.



What should I do when I find out that my relative/friend is missing?

Ring 101 or 999 and ask for the police – have your Herbert Protocol form to hand. The police will only ask for the form, or the information in the form, if the person is reported missing.
